Joshua leads Israel into the Promised Land

After Moses' death, Joshua becomes the leader of Israel. Like Moses, he sends spies into the Promised Land; they are successful and the people of God cross the Jordan. God is faithful to his promise, battling on behalf of the Israelites, and the walled city of Jericho falls. The Israelites disobey God and are defeated at Ai. After a number of battles with Canaanites, Joshua divides the land up among the twelve tribes of Israel. Like Moses, before he dies, Joshua reminds the people to choose between faithfulness and blessing in the land, or disobedience and exile.
