ISAIAH

Judgment and hope

Isaiah is a prophet called by God to deliver a warning of judgement to Israel's corrupt leaders. Yet this dire announcement is threaded with a message of hope that God will one day fulfill his covenant purposes. The first half of the book of Isaiah (Ch. 1 - 39) focuses on the coming judgment and exile while including glimmers of hope. In the second half of the book, hope becomes bright. A new character, God's "Servant," is introduced. The Servant will fulfill God's mission and establish God's kingdom through his sacrificial death and return to life.
