TITUS

Jesus transforms lives

Paul wrote to his colleague Titus, whom he had left on the island of Crete left “put in order what remained.” The Cretan culture was corrupt and sinful, and Paul reminded Titus and the believers that they were to be transformed by the grace of Jesus. Paul encouraged Titus to establish new church leaders whose lives were transformed by Jesus, and to confront the leaders who reflected the culture around them. Paul’s letter serves as a reminder that faith in Jesus is not only something we believe, but something that we practice.

But when the goodness and loving kindness of God our Saviour appeared, he saved us, not because of any works of righteousness that we had done, but according to his mercy, through the water of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit.
